

Tempe Junior Crew Alumnae Program & Contract

Eligibility & Requirements:

Must be Tempe Junior Crew alum including the following:

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Not currently affiliated with the “junior” program
- Have been an active junior club member for a minimum of 12 months
- In good standing with the club
- Competency approval by Head Coach
- Review of Safety Video (checkout DVD from Head Coach)
- Current USRA member in good standing
- TJC waiver on file (w/TJC)
- Float Test on file (w/TJC)
- Membership form with current contact information on file (w/TJC)
- Alumnae Contract on file (w/TJC)
- Tempe Town Lake waiver on file (w/City of Tempe)

Alumnae Use of Equipment Season Fees:

Fall Season (Sept – Dec):	\$100
Spring Season (Jan – May)	\$125
Summer Season (June – July)	\$ 50

Fees to be paid in full at the beginning of each season. Season fees may be prorated monthly, not weekly or daily and are non-refundable. Mail fees to: TJC, PO Box 857, Tempe, AZ 85280

Private or Group Lesson Coaching Fees:

Lessons are provided in consecutive 2-hour minimums

Single	\$50 per lesson
Double/Pair	\$35 per person, per lesson
Four/Quad	\$25 per person, per lesson
Eight	\$20 per person, per lesson

All fees are payable in advance or on the day of private lesson.

Private or Group Coaching Schedule Availability:

All private or group coaching lessons to be scheduled with Head Coach

Fall & Spring Season:

Mon-Fri: 5 AM – 9 AM

Sat/Sun: Flexible

Summer Season:

Mon-Fri: 5 AM – 7 AM

Fri: 5 AM – 9 AM

Sat/Sun: Flexible

Equipment Availability:

The “junior” program in all circumstances has priority for equipment usage.

Fall & Spring Season: Equipment not available Mon – Fri 4 PM – 6:30 PM based on the “junior” program calendar.

Summer Season: Equipment not available Mon - Thurs 7 AM – 9 AM based on the “junior” Learn to Row and Recreation program calendar.

Equipment usage must be scheduled with Head Coach and approved use of types of equipment is based on skill level.

Unauthorized or unscheduled use of equipment will not be tolerated and may result in dismissal from program.

Care & Maintenance of Equipment:

The alum will be responsible for the proper care and use of equipment.

The alum member will pay for equipment willfully or negligently damaged or lost and at a minimum will be responsible for the \$250 insurance deductible.

Competition:

Alum must seek approval from Head Coach for use of equipment for competition, junior equipment use takes priority and Head Coach must be present at competition.

Alum must pay for their share of costs of transportation of equipment to out of town regattas.

Alum must pay their share of costs for coach’s travel and related costs for coaching at out of town regattas.

Alum must register and pay their own entry fees and or any other fees related to regatta competition separate from the “junior” program.

Alum must register as member of: “to be determined” for regatta entry.

Alum must provide own transportation to/from out of town regattas.

Alum may stay at same hotel as juniors provided they are not rooming with juniors and are responsible for making their own arrangements.

Alumnae Code of Conduct:

Will conduct themselves with behavior and actions that are consistent with friendly rivalries, including adherence to the general rules of good sportsmanship, respect for each other, respect for all programs on the lake, respect for each others’ equipment and general behavior that is in line with the development of the sport of rowing.

Will conduct themselves with decorum and good sense, behave courteously and considerately, and refrain from vulgar language.

Will refrain from any conduct or activity that could reasonably be construed as sexual harassment, sexual contact or lewd behavior while representing the club or traveling to, from or during club sponsored events.

Will demonstrate support for TJC coaches, fellow TJC alumni, TJC junior rowers/coxswain, and TJC volunteers.

Will support team spirit for all Tempe Junior Crew events and competitions.

Will respect the authority of the coaches, City of Tempe employees or any other appropriate authorities.

Will pay required season and or coaching fees as required in a timely manner.

Will complete and return all required paperwork and fees in advance of first session on the water.

Alumnae Contract

I have read, understand, meet the requirements and will comply with the provisions set forth for participation in the Tempe Junior Crew Alumnae Program. I agree to abide by its rules and regulations and agree to pay the \$250 insurance deductible in the event of equipment damage or loss during my use; failure to do so will result in my immediate dismissal from the program.
